August Strindberg's *Miss Julie* finds a new home in contemporary London. Directed by Carrie Cracknell (*The Deep Blue Sea*) and written by Polly Stenham (*That Face*), this play was first performed in March 2018 on the Lyttleton Theatre stage, at the National Theatre, London.
