

# MAKE A PENACHO!

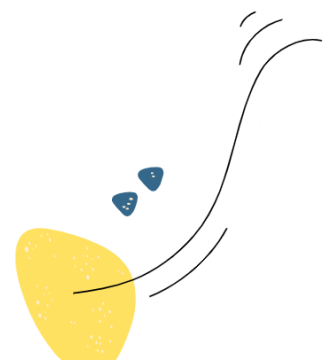
Follow these instructions to make your own version of an Aztec headdress.

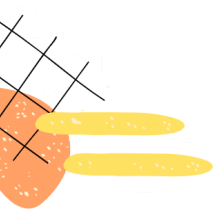
## Supplies:

- Construction paper
- Safety scissors
- School glue
- Tape or staples
- Decoration: feathers, crayons, beads, glitter, etc.

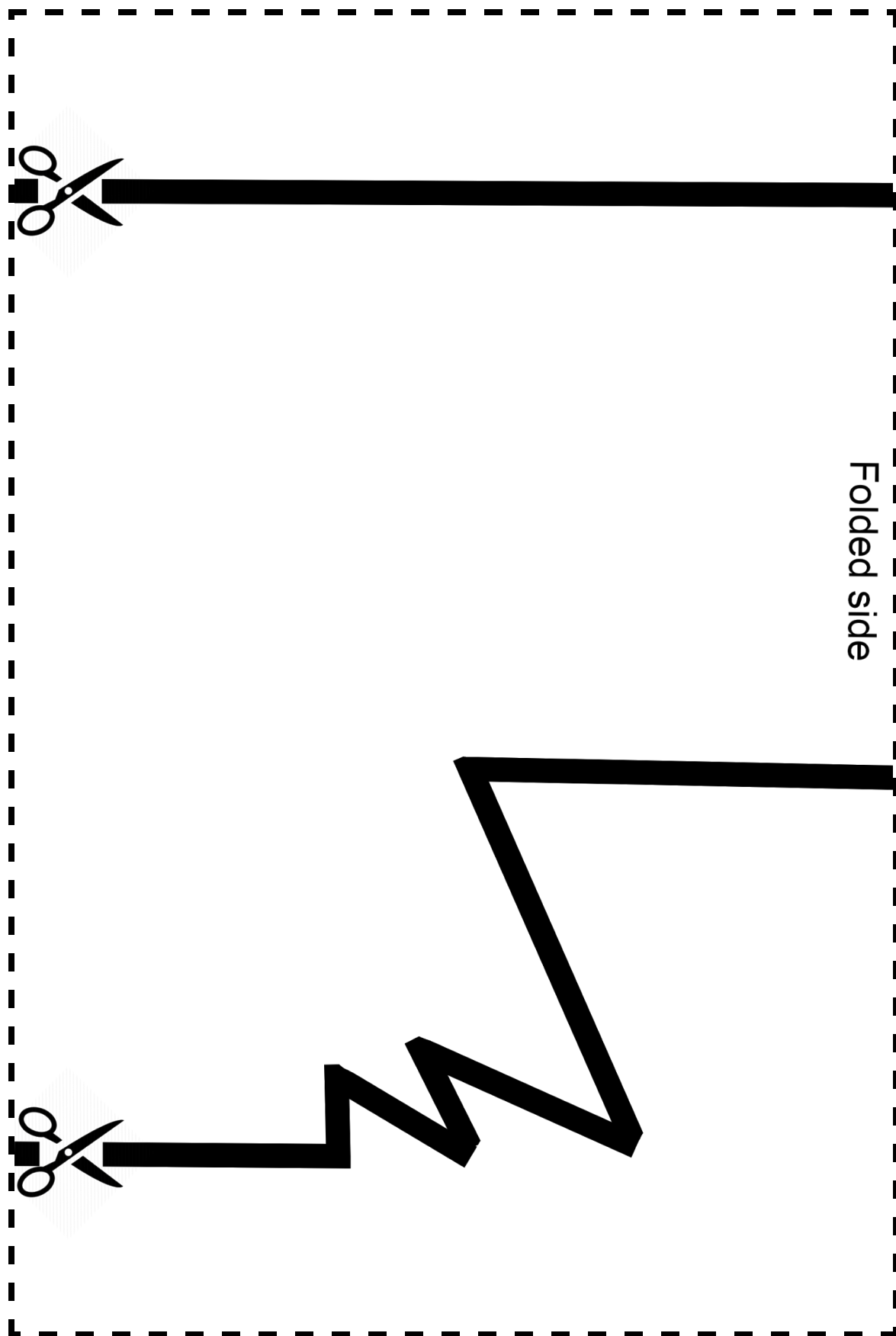
1. Cut out the pattern on the next page along the dotted line.
2. Fold a piece of construction paper in half
3. Place the cut pattern onto the folded construction paper. Match fold line where indicated on the pattern. (you might want to hold it in place with a piece of scotch tape)
4. Cut along the lines of the pattern.
5. Unfold and decorate the larger piece. Use markers, crayons, glitter, etc. Glue feathers along the edges. You can also cut out features using construction paper, too.
6. Fasten ends of the larger piece with the thin strip with tape or staples.
7. Wear your Penacho!

*Remember, when wearing your penancho, it is important to respect the people who honor their heritage through Aztec dance.*
